## Range and Match News

## A Safety Reminder

Just a reminder that Range Safety is every member's responsibility! Keep this in mind every time you are at the range. Just a few things to think about:

When you are on any range and there are other members setting or removing targets downrange **DO NOT HANDLE ANY FIREARMS NO MATER WHAT!**

This would seem like common sense but for some reason there are members that seem to think that it is okay to handle their rifles while other members or down range just because they have there bolt open or out of the gun. Keep in mind that if you were the person downrange you would have no idea that the firearm the person under the shed is handling has the bolt removed.

It is just good SAFETY and manners to not touch or handle your firearms in any way while others are downrange.

Also it is incumbent upon all members to get the name of persons who may violate these safety rules and report them to the Club Officers as soon as possible.

So please help to keep our range a fun and safe place to shoot! --Pat Holsted, Vice-President, Benton Gun Club.

will be required to pay the \$100 range maintenance fee when you rejoin. Club memberships are for a calendar year, running from January 1 through December 31.

If you're a new NRA member be sure to include a copy of your NRA membership card or the address label from your NRA magazine with your club renewal form. This is required to confirm your membership in the NRA. If you don't include this information, your club renewal form will be returned.

From now through January the newsletter will be sent by regular mail only. (In other months you only get the newsletter by email if you specifically requested it by checking the appropriate box on your membership form.) If "NS8" appears after your name on the label then you have not taken the Range and Safety Orientation and will not be sent a 2009 renewal form. If a "9" appears after your name then the Club has received your 2009 renewal and a new gate key will be mailed to you. An "8" behind your name indicates that the Club has not received your 2009 renewal as of the date this newsletter was printed.

The front gate lock was changed to the 2009 lock on December 8, 2008. The 2009 gate keys were mailed on December 22, 2008. The back lock was changed on January 1, 2009. Try your 2009 key before you toss your 2008 key. The 2009 key is the reverse of the 2008 key. The 2009 key will not fit the 2008 lock, and vice versa.

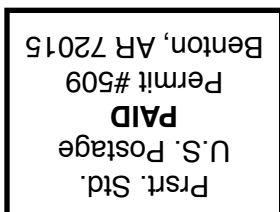
## New Members
